- Teams cook six proteins - pork ribs, boston butt, brisket, lamb, duck and open kangaroo - with six separate hand in intervals. Judging is conducted by a panel and all scores are tallied and contribute to the overall placements. On top of a chance to win trophies or cash, you can also promote your own merchandise.

RULES AND GUIDELINES

Teams cannot sell any meat cooked to punters. Follow all rules and guidelines listed on the back. Be courteous to the patrons as they will ask questions. Allocated times for food serving must be met. Team registration is confirmed upon receipt of competition entry fee. Teams are responsible for cleaning up their own area. The competition is in a carpark, and all care must be taken to minimize any cooking/oil spills. Each team will be financially liable for any clean up required in their respective areas.
